Club Policies:

Members are required to contribute 12 hours of volunteer service to the Columbus Sailing Club each year for projects that maintain and promote the Sailing Club and property.

1. Two (2) club workdays per year.

Normally one is held in the spring to prepare the grounds and assemble boats and one in fall to remove boats from the shoreline close the club grounds.

2. One (1) civic service workday per year.

This is required by lease from the City of Columbus.

Usually the Division of Watercraft sponsors a fall cleanup around the lake, but the activity could be any water related activity such as scout outing day on water.

Members can bring friends and family with them to the Club. Spouse or significant other can use the Club without you being present. Your friends - cannot.

Members must:

- Stake their boats securely on the bank or shore
- Be responsible for their own boat(s) and damage to other boat(s)
- Keep their boat in safe operating condition
- Park in designated parking areas
- Maintain their personal property in the sail loft
- Secure the padlock on the chain when entering
- Keep their trailer in rolling condition
- No campfires of any kind are allowed on the property
